**Required Immunizations:**

- A** Each student should have 4 or more doses of diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (DTP) vaccine or a combination of these vaccines with the following exceptions: (1) a child who received a fourth dose prior to their 4th birthday, must have a fifth dose. (2) a child who received the first dose of Td- adult at or after age seven may meet this requirement with only 3 doses of Td-adult.
- B** Each student should have 4 doses of polio vaccine (OPV), or 4 doses of inactivated polio virus (IPV), or a combination of these vaccines with the following exception: If the third dose of (OPV) or (IPV) is administered on or after their 4th birthday, a fourth dose is not required.
- C** Each student should have 2 doses of measles vaccine. The first dose should be administered on or after the age of 15 months. The second dose should be done between the age of 4 and 6. The combination vaccines of measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) can be used to meet this requirement.
- D** Each student should have 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.
- E** Each student should have 1 dose of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine.
- F** Lead Testing is required for all children.
- G** All students must have a TB risk assessment done, and if a risk for TB must have the additional Mantoux skin test performed by your physician.
